Crochet Minion

PapaBear's Pattern



I have been looking for a Minion pattern, and nothing I could find online was any good. There are a plethora of Al-Generated pics and patterns that turn out nothing like it's supposed to look, so I decided to write my own pattern. *I do not own rights to the Minions*, so *I will not be charging for use of this pattern*.

You may use this pattern freely, but you may not resell this pattern as your own. You may sell your finished product, but be aware that Disney/Pixar corporation may issue a cease and desist for making money on their intellectual property.

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Worsted weight yarn in Black, White, Yellow, and Blue (or whatever color you would like to make the overalls).
- Safety eyes 10mm x2
- Yarn needle
- 4.5mm hook
- Stitch markers (optional)

ABBREVIATIONS:

- SC single crochet
- MR magic ring
- inc increase
- dec decrease
- slst slip stitch
- ch chain
- st(s) stitch(es)
- f/o fasten off. Use whatever technique you wish, but I usually slst into the next st, and pull the tail through.

BODY:

- 1. Using yellow, SC 6 sts into magic ring. (6)
- 2. Increase around. (12)

- 3. (SC, inc) around. (18)
- 4. (SC 2, inc) around. (24)
- 5. (SC, inc) around. (36)
- 6 22. SC around. (36)
 - * Begin stuffing the body.
- 23. (SC, dec) around. (24)
- 24. (SC 2, dec) around. (18)
- 25. (SC, dec) around. (12)
 - * Finish stuffing the body.
- 26. Dec around. (6)
 - * f/o, pulling the circle closed, and weave in end.


ARMS X2:

- 1. Starting with black yarn, SC 4 sts in a MR. (4)
- 2. Inc around. (8)
- 3 4. SC around. (8) Switch to yellow yarn.
- 5 8. SC around. (8)
 - *f/o, leaving a long tail for sewing the arm to the body. Stuff the arm.
- 9. Sew across the opening of the arm, closing the shoulder.

OVERALLS:


- 1. SC 7 sts in a MR. (7)
- 2. Inc around. (14)
- 3. (SC, inc) around (21)
- 4. (SC 2, inc) around (28)
- 5. (SC 2, inc) around, inc in last st. (38)
- 6 7. SC around (38)
- 8. Dec, SC 17, Dec, SC 17. (36)
- 9. SC 8, ch 1, turn. * you will be working this section in rows, not rounds
- 10 12. SC 8, ch 1, turn.
- 13. SC 8
- 14. SLST x5 down the left side of the bib, SC 18, ch 1, turn.
- 15 17. SC 8, ch 1, turn.
- 18. SC 8.
- 19. SLST x5 down the left side of the back bib, SC 10.
- 20. SLST x5 up the right side of the front bib.

- 21. SLST 8, ch 8, connect to the back bib with a slst, slst 7, ch 8, connect to the front bib with a slst.
 - * f/o and weave end in.
 - * Put the overalls on the body.
 - *Sew arms onto either side of the body, between rounds 13-14.



EYES X2:

- 1. SC 5 in a MR. (5)
- 2. Inc around (10)
- 3. f/o and weave in ends.
- 4. Attach blue yarn to one eye with a slst. SC around. (10)
- 5. SLST to second eye. SC around (10), so both eyes are sewn together and edged in blue. f/o, leaving a long tail for sewing.
- 6. Attach 10mm safety eyes to the center of each eye. If you are giving this minion to a child, I suggest using a lighter or match, and melting/smashing the end of the spike on the safety eye, so the child will not be able to pull them off.
- 7. Using the tail, sew eyes to the body, and weave in end.





FEET X2:

- 1. Using black yarn, ch 5, turn.
- 2. SC in second st from ch, SC2, inc in last st. Continuing to work the other side of the chain, SC 3, inc in last st. (10 sts) **Do not join.** You will be working in the round.
- 3 4. SC around. (10)
 - * f/o, leaving a tail for sewing.
 - * Sew the inner faces of the shoes together, so you will only have to sew around once when adding them to the body.
 - * Lightly stuff the feet, and sew to the base of the body. Weave in end.

MOUTH:

*Use black yarn, and embroider a mouth below the eyes.
